### Hamlin Township Board Meeting Wednesday, June 8, 2022, 6pm

**Call to Order:** Supervisor Phil Bombrys, 6:00pm

**Pledge of Allegiance:** Pledge to the flag was given.

**Roll call:** Bombrys present, Gleeson present, Taber present, Collins present, Perkins present.

**Approval of Agenda:** Collins moved to approve the agenda, second by Taber, motion carried.

**Eaton County Report:** Commissioner Rogers reported Public Works and Planning voted to dissolve the Parks Commission. Park millage was discussed.

**Approval of minutes for Board meeting on 5/11/22:** Perkins moved to approve the 5/11/22 Board meeting minutes, second by Gleeson, motion carried.

**Approval of Bills:** Perkins moved to approve bills for GF of \$10,616.27 and Cemetery bills for \$4,679.26, second by Taber, motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report/Budget Amendments:** Perkins reported that we will receive the 2nd installment of ERPA funds. Closing recycling at the end of this month, and looking at property to have another center.

**Reports and communications from Board members:** Bombrys reported July BOR is coming up. Collins motioned to approve pay rate for the deputy clerk to \$17, Second by Gleeson, motion carries.

**Assessor report:** Bombrys had nothing to report.

**Cemetery report:** Collins reported 1 burial, 1 cremains, and 2 foundations. Bombrys reported that cemetery spaces are still violating rules and still expanding.

**Fire Chief's report:** Chief Blackmer reported 17 Fire emergencies, 10 med assist, 1 commercial structure fire, 1 vehicle fire, 2 personal injury crashes, 1 cardiac arrest, 96 burning permits. CCE credits for fire and EMT's coming soon. Will need to get a new reporting system, because the current company went out of business, and it may be about \$2000.

**Facilities report:** Bombrys reported that everything is going well.

**Parks Board report:** Taber reported update on the Pavillian. Looking at 3-5 years for the master plan and it will be presented after the July meeting.

### NEW BUSINESS

**9894 North Fork Way Alcohol License:** 9891 is the actual address. We discussed how Norfolk wants to be a 1 stop shop, and couples have to get a liquor license. All are insured, safeserve trained, etc. Trained all of their staff, always check ID, age sign, no shot policy, no doubles, no self-serve, cut off any who have had too much, all staff gets trained about alcohol, etc. Allow them to have control, monitor it more, couples bring in ice, cups, etc. can't do cash bars without

a liquor license. (paying for it, don't drink as much) Only for venue location and won't move, average guests of 200 guests for every weekend. Board will research and have an update with where we are in July.
