Approval of Agenda: Gleeson moved to approve, second by Taber, motion carried.

Eaton County Report: Commissioner Rogers reported Public Works and Planning met today and Eaton County parks will now have free admission, resident or not, Rogers opposed this; There was also a motion to remove the County Parks Board;

Fire Chief's report: Deputy Chief D'Huyvetter reported 23 Fire emergencies, 8 medical assists, 2 structure fires, 1 Light rescue, 2 Brush fires, 1 commercial structure fire, 2 Mutual Aid, 1 Odor Investigation, 4 Wires Down, 1 Vehicle fire, 1 personal injury, 32 total burning permits. Justin Cassler has resigned; Dan LaLone has joined. Perkins read a report from Eaton Area Medical EMA

Parks Board report: Taber reported the next Meeting will be on Dec. 20, 2022, Taber hopes to have the Park sign in January and the pavilion is done; Possible fundraising with the girl scouts for park playground equipment


