Hamlin Township Board Meeting Wednesday, July 14, 2021, 6pm

Call to Order: Supervisor Phil Bombrys, 6:01pm

Pledge of Allegiance: Pledge to the flag was given.

Roll call: Gleeson present, Taber present, Collins absent and excused; deputy clerk King taking minutes, Perkins present, Bombrys present.

Approval of Agenda: Perkins moved to approve the agenda, second by Gleeson, motion carried.

Eaton County Report: Commissioner Whittum reported on the broadband meeting and possibilities with local companies. Eatran discussed crossing the county line for medical appointments. Recycling discussed. Commissioner Rogers reported parking lot Improvements at Crandell park, public works meeting July 14, study on recycling is being done due to previous abuse.

Approval of minutes for 5/12/21: Perkins moved to approve 6/9/21 minutes, second by Gleeson, motion carried.

Approval of Bills: Perkins moved to approve bills for GF of \$41,246.72 and Cemetery bills for \$6,484.79, second by Taber, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report/Budget Amendments: None.

Reports and communications from Board members: LDFA meeting that was scheduled for Friday was canceled. COG is tomorrow night.

Assessor report: July 20th is BOR.

Cemetery report: King reported 3 foundations, 2 cremains, 1 burial and Bob fixed the Water Hydrant.

Bombrys got the quote for tree work in the amount of \$3780 from Top Notch. Taber motioned to approve, second by Gleeson, motion carried.

Fire Chief's report: Blackmer reported there were 14 runs, 8 Medical Assists, 2 structure fires, 1 commercial structure fire, 1 brush fire and 2 P.I.'s, and 49 burning permits. Training this month was water rescue. Open house is a go for this fall and Blackmer is communicating with the hospital. Old SCBA equipment discussed, Taber motioned to grant authority to the Fire Chief to dispose of the old SCBA equipment. Second by Gleeson, motion carried.

Facilities report: Bombrys discussed replacing the asphalt surrounding the township building and is getting estimates on replacement options with asphalt or concrete.

Parks Board report: Taber reported discussion on having the park sprayed for mosquitos and trail clean up for trail run on July 20th. Clean up of Smithville park took place July 1st. Bombrys reported on the Eagle Scout pavilion project.
