**Hamlin Township Annual Meeting and Public Budget Hearing  
Wednesday, March 23, 2022, 6:00pm**

**Call Annual Meeting to Order:** Supervisor Bombrys called the Hamlin Township Annual meeting to order at 6:00pm. People in attendance introduced themselves. Five people were in attendance.

**Pledge of allegiance:** Pledge to the flag was given.

**Introductions:** Those present included: Keith Barber - resident, Barbara Rogers - resident/county commissioner, Lou Lewfolk - resident, Denise Perkins - resident/treasurer, Phil Bombrys - resident/supervisor, Matt Gleeson - resident/trustee, Renee Taber - resident/trustee, Jacque Collins - resident/clerk.

**Minutes of 2021 Annual Meeting:** were reviewed. Moved to approve by Barbra Rogers, second by Denise Perkins, motion carries by the public.

**Salary Resolutions:** Supervisor Bombrys reported the Township Board passed the proper resolutions for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. Supervisor salary \$10,000 plus \$5000 if by Township Board action the Fire Chief reports directly to the Township supervisor, unchanged. Clerk salary \$21,500 plus \$700 per election, unchanged; Treasurer salary \$21,500, unchanged. Public discussed cost of living raises. Lou moved to approve to have the Township board, on an annual basis, consider a cost of living stipend, based on service, cost of living as it shows in annual assessments, at the township boards discretion, not to exceed cost of living, supported by Tabor, Hand vote, 3 yes's, 1 no, 1 abstain, motion carries.

Perkins, Taber, Collins and Bombrys present and moved to the table. Bombrys reviewed the budget and fielded public questions and comments.

**Budget Hearing:** Township Board convened. Moved by Perkins, second by Taber to adopt the proposed budget of \$35,270.58 for the Cemetery, \$422,342.80 for the Fire Millage Fund and on the basis of cost center totals for the General Fund for a total of \$1,621,819.44 for fiscal year April 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023, motion carries.
