**EATON COUNTY REPORT:**

- Undersheriff Cook presented the 911 report. There were 54 incidents in Hamlin Township in August. He reported that there were three meth dumps in the Township.

Moved by Gleeson, second by Henne, PASSED, to approve up to \$4,500.00 for three automatic door openers from Overhead Door with funds from Fire Millage account.

**PARKS BOARD REPORT:** Discussed plans for park bench. Discussed hiring a Parks Maintenance position for Hamlin Park. Moved by Henne, second by Boomer, PASSED, to approve \$1,500.00 per year for two hours per week for a parks maintenance position. Perkins will create a new budget account of 101-751-702.2.
