Eaton County Report: Commissioner Barb Rodgers reported COVID-19 numbers for the county. 1,613 in Eaton county, 1243 recovered cases, 351 active cases, 19 deaths, 577 being monitored. Hamlin county currently has 27 cases.

Approval of Bills: Perkins moved to approve bills for GF for \$18,931.07, and Cemetery for \$880.41, second by Collins, motion carries.
